Guidelines for grant applications

Grants are for projects that will see local Uniting Church congregations in Qld become directly engaged in mission with their, or another, community. Priority will be given for grants that align with our vision to;

- Transform Families
- Engage with Community
- Nurture people's Faith

Projects should;

- Be Strategic, capable of having a lasting impact with measurable outcomes.
- Represent a complete project or an identifiable component of a larger project.
- Align with the Vision & Values of the Uniting Church in Qld.

Grants should be utilised within 12 months of approval and cannot be used for any other activity without the approval of the RUC. Groups that fail to properly acquit the approved grants may be asked to return the funds to the RUC. The decision of the Redcliffe Uniting Church Council on applications is final. The minimum amount of any grant is \$1,000, maximum \$3,000. *Your Project must be approved by your own Church Council.*
